- At least 1 Player must be on a current 8-ball or 9-ball team in SDAPA.

\* Division Winners (1<sup>st</sup> Place/high points finishers) may advance to Championships if more slots are awarded to SDAPA. Players advancing to the Championships must have 20 match scores in the corresponding format within the 2 years preceding March 2024, and must be on a 2024 Spring Session roster in the format for which they qualify. If the winning team's combined team Skill Cap is greater than 10, then they must have started the session as 10/under & cannot be greater than 12 to play in the Championships.

Due to scheduling constraints, players who are participating in the 8-Ball Classic singles are not eligible for the 9-Ball Doubles Championship. Players who are participating in the 9-Ball Shootout singles are not eligible for the 8-Ball Doubles Championship.
