Captains Log, February 2nd, 2020

Week 5 is the week that all unpaid members listed on a roster get removed. Teams that are NOT qualified for Championships can simply add the players back to the roster provided they pay their membership. Any player added at week 5 or beyond must pay their membership fees in order to play. If you play someone that does not pay their membership, we will mark them paid and the team becomes responsible for that member's fees regardless of whether you collect their money or keep them on the team. So be sure they plan on submitting-membership fees before you add and play them. Qualified teams are not allowed to make any roster changes from this point forward. The current roster (minus anyone taken off the roster for non-payment of membership fees) will be your City Championship roster, provided they meet all of the eligibility requirements.

As of this writing, we now have 65 teams signed up for the <u>Southwest Challenge</u>. We will be sending out entry forms soon. Teams on the waiting list will also receive entry forms, but please note that we will not be able to confirm your participation until we get closer to the deadline due to the popularity of this event and potential full field. Players must have a minimum of 10 eight ball scores within the last two years by the due date of February 22nd. February 22nd is the deadline to submit your completed entry form and fees. Waiting list teams will probably receive notice before the deadline whether they will be allowed to participate. Skill levels lock on March 2nd.

Upcoming Tournament Schedule-

March 7-8 <u>Spring Singles Regional</u> – This event will take place at <u>Pockets</u>, with the exception of the 1-3 tier in 9 Ball (Riverside). You should be receiving your entry form packets in the coming weeks. Tentative numbers show 63 participants in 8 Ball with one winner in each tier group of skill level 2-3, skill level 4, skill level 5, skill level 6 and skill level 7 for a total of 5 players advancing to the <u>Poolplayer Championships</u>. In 9 Ball, tentative numbers show 37 participants with one winner each for skill level 4-5, skill level 6-7 and skill level 8-9.

March 21 <u>8 Ball and 9 Ball Doubles Qualifier</u> (<u>Library</u>) – This event is ONLY OPEN to players competing in our Doubles leagues and you may only compete in the qualifiers for the formats in which you are actually competing. We will be qualifying one winner in 9 Ball and 2 winners in 8 Ball for the Doubles Championships in Las Vegas during the Poolplayer Championships.

March 26-29- APA 8 Ball Southwest Challenge

April 4-5 <u>Team Captains Championship Qualifier</u> (<u>Library</u>) - This is the qualifier for the <u>Team Captains Championship</u> in Las Vegas in August. Teams consist of 3 to 5 players. All must be captains in Spring 2020 and must have been a captain in at least one of the 2 previous sessions (Summer or Fall of 2019). Watch for flyer soon with details. Field is limited to first 32 teams signed up. Teams will play either Saturday or Sunday, not both. We will qualify 2 teams for the Captains Championship from this event. We will start a waiting list for extra slots if they become available.

April 29-May 3 APA Poolplayer Championships - 9 Ball Shootout, 8 Ball Classic, Wheelchair Championships, 8 Ball Doubles and 9 Ball Doubles Championships

May 9- Junior City Championships

May 16-17- Spring Session Blast

May 30-31- 9 Ball City Championships and Ladies 8 Ball City Championships (4 9 Ball teams advance to World Pool Championships and 2 Ladies teams advance to Ladies 8 Ball Championships)

June 13- Masters City Championships-and Jack n Jill Doubles Championship Qualifier- 3 teams advance to Masters Championships and one team advances to Jack n Jill Doubles Championships

July 9-12- Junior Championships - Renaissance Hotel, St. Louis, MO

August 6-15- World Pool Championships - Westgate Hotel and Casino, Las Vegas - 8 Ball and 9 Ball World Pool Championships , Ladies 8 Ball Championships , Masters Championships , Team Captain Championships and Jack n Jill Championships
