Congratulations to all of the teams advancing to Nationals! It took more than one full page of our newsletter to list all of the teams representing San Diego in this year's APA World Pool Championships.

Qualifying for the 2019 APA World Pool Championships is already under way with the start of this Summer Session. Open 8 Ball and 9 Ball divisions are up and running. Ladies 8 Ball started back up last week. Masters starts back up on July 14th and our brand new Doubles leagues start in July, also. We are taking signups for the Masters and Doubles leagues, so contact the league office if you wish to put a team in.

The 8 Ball and 9 Ball Doubles leagues are brand new to San Diego, but are not new for APA. We had previously only done blind draws from interested parties for the slots awarded to San Diego APA to compete in the <u>Doubles Championships</u> in Las Vegas. This past year that is just finishing up, we changed that to a qualifying tournament for the teams that advanced to Nationals. This current year, we are conducting bi-weekly league play for each of the two formats and you will have to be competing in these leagues to have a chance to earn a spot to Nationals. The interest is certainly there and we are already signing up teams to compete.

These Doubles leagues will play on alternating Saturdays at 3pm. 8 Ball Doubles starts on July 21st and 9 Ball Doubles starts on July 28th. The handicap limit for this format is 10. The roster limit is 3. Each match will consist of two singles matches and a doubles match, using alternating shot. The two singles matches combined skill levels also must be 10 or lower. You can have just two people on your team or you can have a full roster of 3. You can play just the two in an entire match or you can play all 3, with 2 of the players each playing a singles match and a combination of the others playing in the doubles. It's entirely up to each team. Teams must start the session with a handicap no higher than 10. If anyone goes up during the session, we will allow the handicaps to add up to 11 for a match, but at 12, you will either need to add a 3rd player if you don't already have one, or you will have to make a roster change.

8 Ball Doubles will have two singles matches to start. The scoring works the same for these singles matches as Open 8 Ball leagues where you can skunk your opponent for a 3-0 win, or 2-0 if your opponent wins a game, but doesn't get to the hill, or 2-1 if your opponent does make it to the hill. The Doubles match is scored double the singles match. So the 3 scoring possibilities are 6-0, 4-0 or 4-2. In 9 Ball, we use the same match ups as 8 Ball with 2 singles matches and one doubles match with a handicap limit of 10. Points are exactly the same in 9 Ball as Open 9 Ball with up to 20 points awarded based on how badly you beat your opponent, and 9 Ball doubles is double points with up to 40 points available. League fees are \$30 per team for Doubles league. Coaching is limited to 1 per game, per the new APA team manual. Because there are singles matches that generate handicap scores, players don't necessarily have to be already playing in APA to participate in Doubles. There are eligibility requirements to be eligible for higher level tournament play, but someone can just play Doubles, which also makes them eligible for the Singles program in the format in which they are competing once they get 10 scores within the last 2 years. It's a quick and exciting new format that we expect to be very popular once we get the kinks worked out. Saturday afternoon is perfect where you can play your match and still have your Saturday night free to have your normal date night or find a pool tournament to play in. It's your choice. You can play in just the 8 Ball Doubles, just the 9 Ball Doubles or you can play in both. They are on alternating Saturdays, so there is no interference. Masters Divisions will be the same weekend as 9 Ball Doubles in case any Masters players would like to play in 8 Ball Doubles on alternating weekends.
