Then you can click on each individual player listed under our San Diego APA league and click to receive notifications. It will tell you each time they are scheduled to play, what table they are playing on, who their opponent is and whether they won or lost. There are also tournament brackets. Joseph Hankins (skill level 8) is defending his 2018 Championship victory in the skill level 6-9 bracket. Joseph is an 8 at just 15 years of age. We wish all of our Juniors the best of luck this week. Genevieve Ahlers, Damian Rockafellor, Justyn Martin, Laird Hubbard, Jake Barreiro and Joseph Hankins are the Juniors from San Diego. You can also search Compusport individually for following their progress. There are close to 400 kids competing in the Junior Championships this year.

Masters just started back up. There is currently room for more teams. Masters is a non-handicapped format where you play a combination of 8 Ball and 9 Ball in races to 7. We play a couple of Saturdays a month. Teams consist of 3-5 players and 3 play in a match. <u>Contact the league office</u> if you are interested in finding out more about this fun and competitive format.
